#### **RULES OF FISHING**

Fitzwilliam Wentworth Estate requires all members to familiarize themselves with the fishery rules. The purchase of a permit signifies acceptance of all rules and there is a zero-tolerance policy on litter and aggressive behaviour

**Booking on:** All members must book on prior to commencing a 'session' this should be done via the online booking system. Where internet access is unavailable via text or a telephone call to number 07747 793540, stating your full name & the days you intend to fish  
Full Membership allows night-time fishing to a maximum of 72 hours with 3 rods, after which an angler must leave the lake for a minimum period of 24 hours  
A 'session' is always counted from the time of arrival on the first day to the time of departure on the third day, both of which **must** be in daylight hours  
You are not required to book on for day sessions although you are restricted to fishing sunrise – sunset

**Mid – Week Membership** Mid-week permit holders your permit allows you to book on between Monday to Thursday {Max 3 nights}  
It is important if you have booked on to fish a Thursday night that you vacate your fishing peg by no later than 10am on the Friday morning

**Parking:** For parking areas and restrictions please refer to the map  
Parking in the upper car park near Morley is restricted to 15 cars  
Strictly no vehicular movement in the hours of darkness  
No vehicles to drive beyond the Western end car park, no attempting to offload equipment to bankside  
Drive slowly on all roads Max 15mph whilst entering or exiting the fishery and always courteous to other parkland users

**Access:** Lock and scramble all combination codes on all gates immediately after entry/exit under NO circumstances should you leave the gates open  
Combination codes must not be provided to any visitors under any circumstances  
Visits by a non-permit holder to an angler are not permitted except for wives/partners  
Strictly no access to the lakes via Wentworth Woodhouse, use only the Fisheries entrance at East Lodge  
Anglers leaving the site during the hours of daylight (for a maximum of 1 hour) must reel in, you cannot leave your equipment unattended in a swim and go to work returning in the evening.  
Takeaway delivery drivers are not permitted on Estate grounds and orders should be collected from the main fishery gate or directly from the shop.  
Under no circumstances should any wildlife or bankside vegetation be interfered with or cut back without permission

**Behaviour:** Drunkenness and rowdy behavior are totally unacceptable, and the use of recreational drugs is strictly prohibited  
Consumption of alcohol is to be kept to an absolute minimum  
Should the need arise to use a toilet (other than to pass water), bag it, bin it, take it home to dispose of properly  
No loud radios, drones, BBQ's, gatherings {visits by non-members}  
Members are requested to assist in bailiffing the water themselves by reporting anglers who flout the
