RULES OF FISHING FOR ALL PERMITS HOLDERS

The Fitzwilliam Wentworth Estate requires all permit holders to familiarize themselves with the fishery rules set out below. Purchase of a permit signifies acceptance of all rules and there is a zero-tolerance policy on litter and aggressive behaviour.

Fishing times: Sunrise to sunset. Most weather apps have this information available. No access onto Estate ground before Sunrise. Fishing lines must be clear of the water at Sunset, no lines should be left in the water while equipment is being packed away. All anglers must be off the fishery before darkness no exceptions.

Parking: Vehicles must only be parked in the designated locations, (see map on permit). No access onto Mill Dam with a vehicle unless you're fishing for the day. Always keep off the grass with vehicles, only registered disabled anglers displaying a badge may park on the disabled pegs (see map) on the North side of Mill Dam. Anglers may offload/pick up tackle on the hard standing verge on the left-hand side of the road between the bridge and the island, before parking in the designated car parks. Drive slowly (max 15mph) on all roads whilst entering or exiting the fishery and be courteous to other parkland users.

Access: Lock and scramble all combination codes on all gates immediately after entry/exit. Under NO circumstances should gates be left open. Failure to adhere to this rule may result in a ban. Combination codes must not be shared with any visitors under any circumstances.

Behaviour: Pedestrian visitors are allowed via public/permissive routes on foot (no vehicles/bicycle/motorbikes). Drunkenness and rowdy behavior are totally unacceptable, and the use of recreational drugs is strictly prohibited, no alcohol is to be consumed on the fishery. Should the need arise to use a toilet (other than to pass water), all waste must be bagged and taken away from site. No Loud Radios, drones, BBQs are allowed. Please respect all other anglers' peace and quiet. Members are requested to assist in bailiffing the fishery; reporting anglers who flaunt the rules, trespassers and anti-social behavior etc. Under no circumstances should any wildlife or vegetation be interfered with or cut back. Any large groups of people visiting anglers will be asked to leave and this will be recorded on an angler's permit.

Litter: LITTERING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES ANGLERS IN THIS BREACH OF THIS RULE WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE FISHERY AND BANNED

Litter must be removed from all swims and the surrounding area and taken away from the fishery (whether it was there on arrival or not). This includes cigarette ends.

Dogs: Only one dog is allowed per angler and must always keep under control and on a leash. Any dog mess must be removed from the fishery and taken home.

Bailiffs: The bailiffs reserve the right to check rigs in use at any time and anglers must reel in, immediately if asked to take part in a rig check.
